Over the past week, residents here at Woodstock Residential Care Home have been taking part in playing many different games – competing in the Woodstock Commonwealth Games!

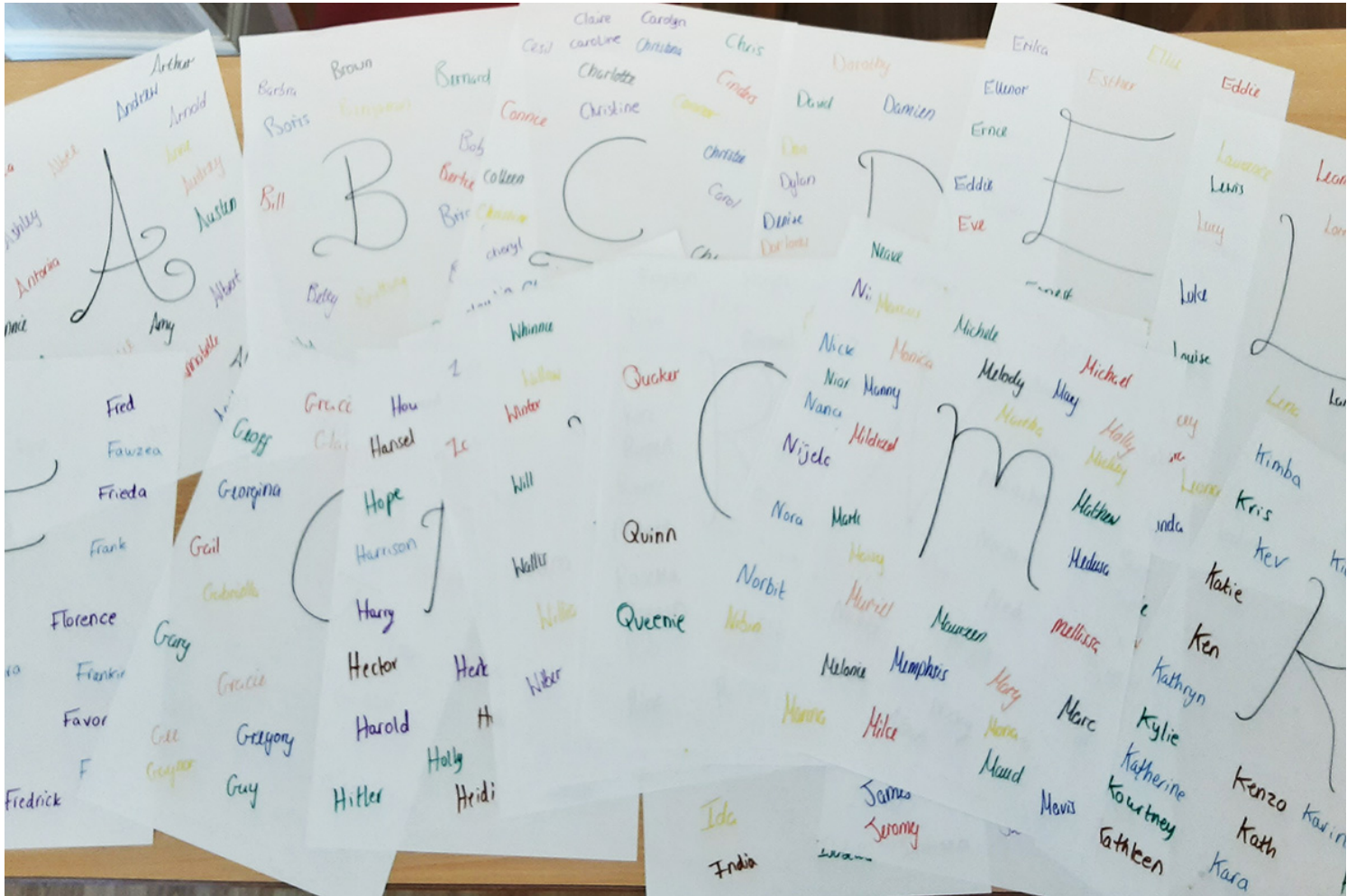
